33RD PULIMOOD MEMORIAL ORATION 2024 UNRAVELING THE PROMISE AND PERILS OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

The 33rd Susan George Pulimood Memorial Oration, an annual event celebrating academic excellence was held on 23rd July 2024 at the school premises. This year, the prestigious oration was delivered by Professor Shanika Karunasekera, Deputy Dean (Academic) at the Faculty of Engineering and Information Technology, University of Melbourne, Australia.

Professor Shanika is a fellow Visakhian who received the UNESCO Gold Medal for the Best Engineering Student and completed her PhD in Electrical Engineering at the University of Cambridge, UK in 1994. She was awarded a National Carrick Citation in recognition of her outstanding contributions to university teaching in Australia within five years of joining academia which was a remarkable achievement.

Her thought-provoking address was titled, “ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE: The Dream, The Nightmare, and the Reality.”

The Professor captivated the audience with an in-depth exploration of the journey of Artificial Intelligence (AI) from its conceptual beginnings to its transformative presence in modern life. Drawing from her own research, Professor Karunasekera provided a balanced and insightful perspective on how humanity can responsibly harness the power of AI for the greater good.

In addition to the oration, the event celebrated the academic brilliance and multifaceted talents of Visakhians. Students who excelled in the 2022 and 2023 Local Advanced Level Examinations were honored for their exceptional achievements and outstanding performance.

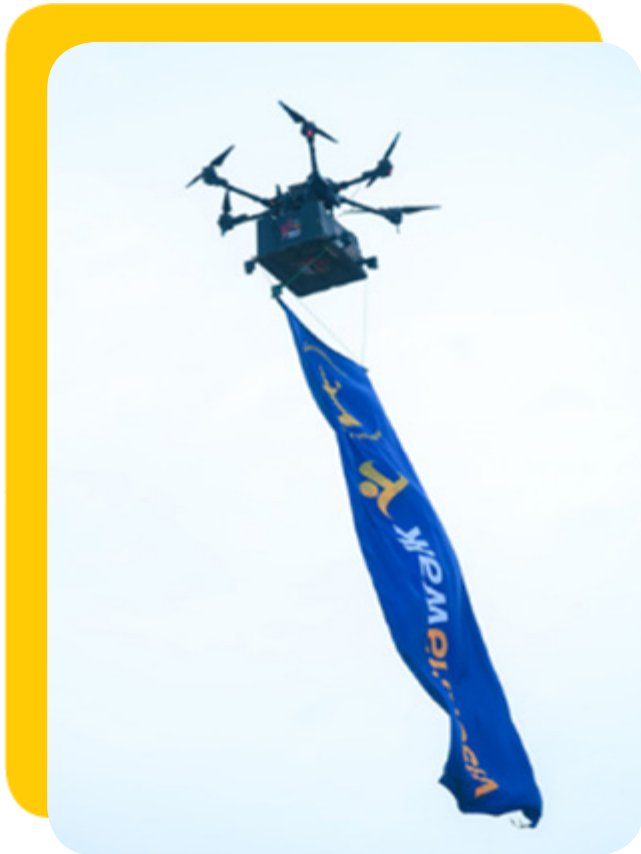


VISAKHA WALK & CARNIVAL 2024 AN UNFORGETTABLE EVENING

Visakha Walk & Carnival 2024 once again proved why it is one of the most anticipated events on the OGA Calendar.

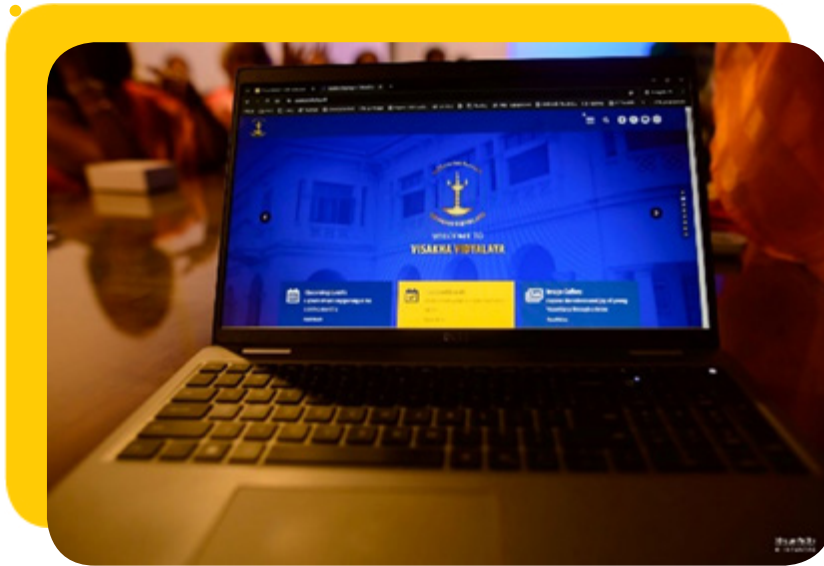

VISAKHIANS IN THE SPOTLIGHT

MENACA CALYANERATNE HONOURED WITH GOLD AWARD FOR HUMANITARIAN WORK

At the 14th Top 50 Career and Professional Women Global Awards, held on 7th November 2024 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, Menaca Calyaneratne, an alumna of Visakha Vidyalaya, was bestowed with the prestigious Gold Award for Excellence in Strategic Leadership in Humanitarian Work.

Menaca serves as the Global Head of Employee Relations at Save the Children International and brings over 24 years of dedicated service to the field of children's rights. Her remarkable career spans media and communications, advocacy, child rights governance, child safeguarding, and human resources.

Menaca's journey began in Sri Lanka, where she worked as a Communications Officer for Save the Children. For 12 years, she was the organisation's spokesperson, liaising with local and international media to advocate for children's rights. She played a pivotal role in highlighting the plight of children during the 2004 tsunami and the armed conflict in Sri Lanka. She later became the International Child Safeguarding Director for Asia, supporting 13 countries, and in 2022, was appointed Global Head of Employee Relations, overseeing 60 countries globally. She is also an accomplished trainer in child rights and safeguarding and a certified investigator into cases of child sexual exploitation and abuse.

Menaca received her early education at Visakha Vidyalaya in Badulla and Bambalapitiya. She holds a Bachelor's degree in English and Journalism from the University of Colombo and a Master's degree in Communication and Journalism from the University of Madurai, India. Outside her professional commitments, Menaca is a poet and released her debut poetry collection, *A Fistful of Stars* in 2019.

Reflecting on the honour, Menaca shared, "Humanitarian work is immensely challenging and often overlooked in the context of awards. It involves protecting vulnerable individuals during crises such as natural disasters and armed conflicts. We strive to address injustice, advocate for the voiceless, and safeguard the rights of those affected. This award is a tribute to all humanitarian workers who tirelessly support the most



marginalised and vulnerable, particularly children.”

The Gold Award was selected by an international panel of judges from among 296 nominations globally. Menaca Calyaneratne’s outstanding contributions serve as an inspiration to many, and her achievements bring pride to the Visakha Vidyalaya community.

First Local and Female Country Manager of HBL Sri Lanka

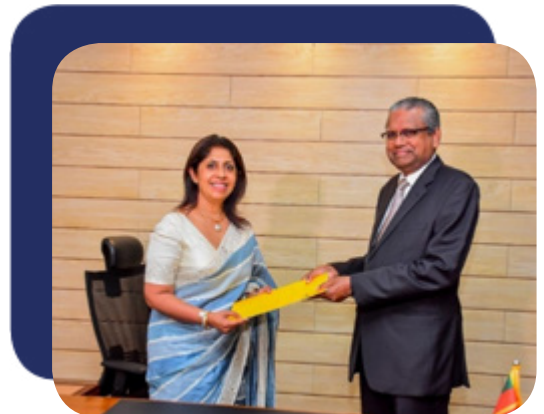

She frequently conducts career talks at universities and schools, aiming to inspire young mathematicians to explore Actuarial Science – a globally respected and rewarding career path.

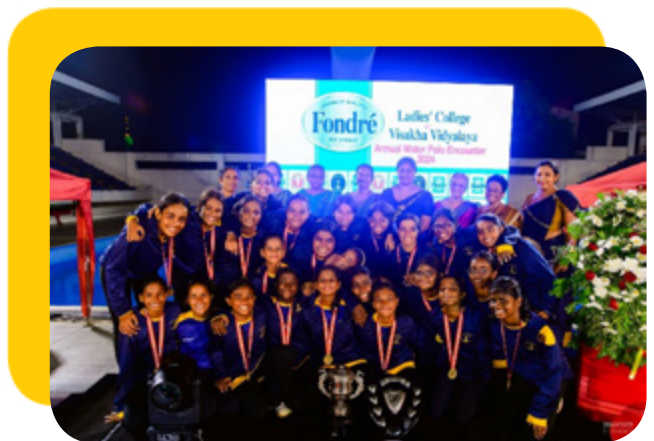
VISAKHA RECLAIMS THE M.N. EDUSSURIYA TROPHY

Honoring the Legacy of Dr Malani Dias

A Trailblazer in Sri Lankan Archaeology and Epigraphy

It is with profound sadness Visakha Vidyalaya OGA announces the passing of Dr. Malani Dias, on August 31, 2024, at the age of 81. Dr. Dias was a distinguished archaeologist and expert in Epigraphy, whose significant contributions to the field have left an indelible mark on Sri Lankan history and heritage.

Dr. Dias began her remarkable career at the Department of Archaeology in 1968, where she served for 35 years, ultimately becoming the Director of Epigraphy and Numismatics. Her academic journey began at Weragoda Vijayaba Vidyalaya, then Southlands College in Galle, and later Visakha Vidyalaya in Colombo. She earned her BA in Oriental Languages from the University of Ceylon in 1967, her MA in Sinhala Language from Kelaniya University in 1985, and her Ph.D. in Sinhalese Epigraphy from the School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London in 1989.

Dr. Dias was a prolific scholar, authoring numerous publications, including *Epigraphia Zeylanica* Vol. VIII and *Epigraphical Notes*. Her research, particularly on the growth of Buddhist monastic institutions in Sri Lanka, has been widely recognized and respected both nationally and internationally.

Dr. Dias delivered the 9th Pulimood oration in the year 1999 and was awarded the Swarna Award from the Ministry of National Heritage in 2014.

May she attain the Supreme Bliss of Nibbana.
